1013C - A6MARR Traffic Mitigation Measures, Church Road, Gillbent Road and Grove Lane, Cheadle Hulme

Stockport Council undertook a consultation earlier this year to inform the development of traffic mitigation measures that will seek to manage the impact of the A6 to Manchester Airport Relief Road (A6MARR) on local communities. As part of the above Stockport Council is constructing the following:-

- Improved pedestrian crossing facilities in the form of providing tactile paving on all approaches and upgrading the refuge islands at the mini roundabout at the junction of Gillbent Road, Hulme Hall Lane and Church Road;
- Full-width lay-by outside the Co-Op food store south of Hulme Hall Road to provide short-term on-street parking close to the shops
- Dropped kerbs and tactile paving across all side roads along the length of Gillbent Road;
- Localised footway widening at the southern junction with The Circuit and Rushfield Road to improve alignment and reduce pedestrian crossing distances;
- New Pedestrian refuge island and tactile paving south of Ashdown Close to provide addition informal crossing facility for pedestrians, and widened footway south of Rushfield Road;
- Improved pedestrian crossing facilities in the form of tactile paving and upgraded refuge island across the Gillbent Road arm of the mini roundabout at the Grove Lane junction;
- New roundabout warning sign and bollards on the Stanley Road arm of the mini roundabout with Gillbent Road.

- Provision of a Pedestrian controlled crossing on Grove Lane, with improved access into South Park adjacent to the western boundary of the Pointing Dog;
- Relocation of the bus stop currently outside No 9 Grove Lane to a position east of Willow Bank;

These mitigation works are planned to start week commencing 12th February 2018 for a 10 week duration.

The Principal Contractor undertaking these works is Solutions SK.

The council apologizes for any inconvenience caused, and will endeavor to minimize any disruption during these works.
