You can apply via the online application for a range of hard landscaping materials to support construction of your planned project. There is also the chance to receive additional support and training as part of the project. You may have a wall that needs rebuilding, a path that needs resurfacing or you may want to build some raised beds to make gardening easier and more accessible.

- To allow communities to benefit t from construction materials
- To provide volunteering opportunities in the local community
