SCOPING OPINION - SEMMMS A6 TO MANCHESTER AIRPORT RELIEF ROAD

I refer to your letter, dated 4th April 2013, in respect of the above which has sought clarification whether or not the original Scoping Opinion submitted in May 2010 remains valid.

Having assessed the amendments to the scheme and taken account of the initial scheme design as formally scoped, it is the City Council's opinion that the original Scoping Opinion as provided on the 5th May 2010 remains valid. Notwithstanding this, it is noted that:

- the area currently consisting of Manchester Business Park and off-airport car parking facilities and which is an integral element of Airport City North and the Enterprise Zone, is marked as a Site of Nature Conservation Importance on Figure 2c (Ecology). This designation should be amended to reflect current land use.

and

- Woodhouse Park on Figure 2d (Land Use, Local Policy and Ground Conditions) is actually Painswick Park.
